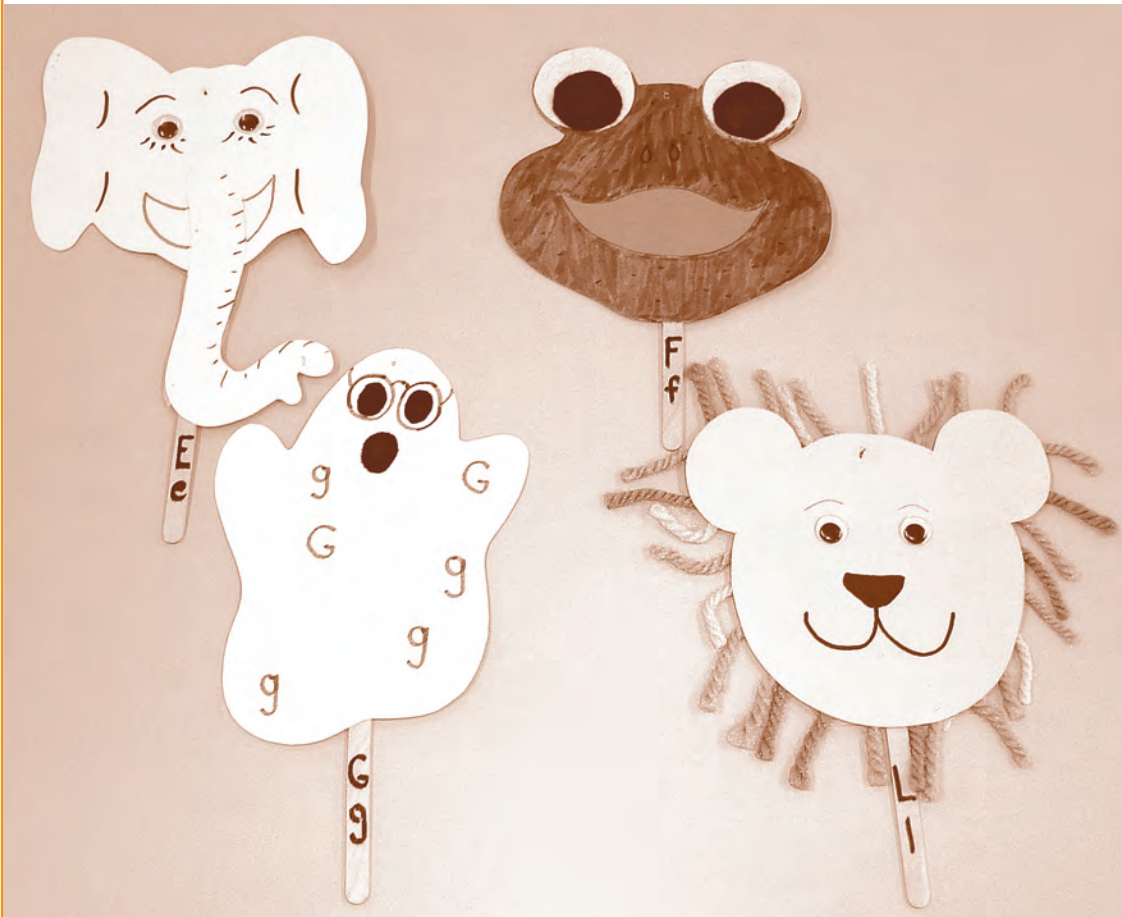


C U R R I C U L U M

They are very simple, made with construction paper and popsicle sticks. "These stick puppets are so cute! We do them every year. I've been to some homes where the puppets were displayed like a border in the

child's room and even in the family room! One went up each time it was completed. This gave parents a chance to reinforce the letter at home. This is especially beneficial to our five and six-year-olds who attend kindergarten and Head Start. Letters and sounds are introduced as young as 30 months."
